



International Cooperation

Background

The objective of international cooperation as part of the Work Package 3, EURC working program, is to cooperate with international organizations and establish new or maintain the previous collaboration with different recognized organizations such as ICAR, WHFF, EHRC, EUBSF, ESF, EAAP, EURC-EAB, etc. This could be achieved via exchange of information with such organizations in relation to EURC's work activities.

Work performed and achievements

Interbull Centre as the EURC for bovine breeding has maintained cooperation with different organizations such as ICAR, WCGALP, ADSA and EAAP. The current collaboration is as joint ICAR-Interbull meeting in Verona, Italy (June 2026) with several relevant topics for EURC working programs, including validations and PREP database.

More collaboration will be with WCGALP this year in July, although the location is in the non-EU country (USA), relevant topics for the EURC will be presented.

Additionally, the cooperation will continue by possible joint webinar with endangered breed (EAB) and exchange of information by recognition of the breeds of in danger.

Results and Impact

This cooperation will create opportunities to strengthen collaboration with existing organizations and establish partnerships with new ones.
